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Curriculum:

Subject	Unit Description				
English	In this unit, students listen to, read, view and interpret multimodal texts to explore the language features and text structures of procedural texts in imaginative and informative contexts. They create a digital multimodal procedure from a literary context.				
Maths	In this unit students apply a variety of mathematical concepts in real-life, lifelike and purely mathematical situations. Through the proficiency strands - understanding, fluency, problem-solving and reasoning - students have opportunities to develop understandings of: number & place value, fractions & decimals, patterns & algebra and data representation & interpretation.				
Science	In this unit students make links between external features of living things and the environments in which they live. They consider how the needs of living things are met in a variety of habitats.				
HASS	In this unit students will describe the features of a local, familiar place. They will discuss which features are constructed, managed and natural.				
Technology	In this unit, students will explore the characteristics and properties of materials and components that are used to produce designed solutions. They will design and make a spinning toy.				
Health	In this unit students describe physical and social changes that occur as they grow. The describe their personal strengths and achievements and discuss how these are acknowledged and celebrated. Students identify similarities and differences, and recognowledged discussive contributes to identities
