- By the end of 2022 upper 2 bands percentange in NAPLAN targets are:- Writing: Year 3 40%; Year 5 40%; Reading: Year 3 40%; Year 5 40%.

- Continuing intensive interventions for students working below NMS with teacher aides.
- Purchasing more reading books for the lower school.
- Continuing On Demand Writing in Term 1 and 3 and teacher aide supported writing improvement hour.
- Implementing 1 hour per term data conversations with Principal, Deputy Principal, Support teacher and Classroom Teacher, aligned to Radar on Reading,
- Implementing Zones of Regulation as a whole school approach to support student emotional regulation and providing a common language and Trauma informed practices.
- Implementing the Heggarty approach from P-2 to enhance phonemic awareness in the lower years.
- Releasing teachers one day per term to plan quality curriculum units of work for the following term in teams.
- Literacy Coach to support teachers implementation of the Geebung Reading and Writing Program.
- Employing a Speech Language Pathologist for an additional day per fortnight. The SLP will work collaboratively with the Support Team to support identified students and participate in the implementation and programming of Oral Language and early years' phonemic awareness development.
- Continuing to refine and strengthen transitions to prep and to the feeder high schools.
- Developing the strategic leadership capacity of the leadership team through targeted executive coaching and professional development.
