School review conducted 25 to 27 October 2022

Every Queensland state school is reviewed by the Department of Education at least once every four years. School reviews provide important feedback to support schools in continuing to deliver quality education and improve learning outcomes for students.



Review highlights

- ✓ School community members speak of the school's 'community spirit' and 'genuine friendliness'.
- ✓ Staff members have a strong ethic of care for students.
- ✓ There is binding collegiality in teaching staff teams and a 'pool of talent'.
- ✓ Students love the school and the teachers in it – 'all the teachers are nice'.

Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- ➔ Review and strengthen the school's current leadership structures to create clearly defined school-wide roles, specific responsibilities and accountabilities to lead implementation of the future agreed Explicit Improvement Agenda (EIA) and strategic direction.
- ➔ Collaboratively identify and shape an agreed approach to student behaviour support, enacting it with fidelity to ensure whole-school consistency of processes, attendant consequences and follow-up communication.
- ➔ Collaboratively develop and deepen teacher knowledge and skills to implement the Australian Curriculum and fulfil requirements of the P-12 curriculum, assessment and reporting framework.
- ➔ Collaboratively devise, clearly communicate and rigorously action an unambiguous EIA focusing on educational achievement, wellbeing and engagement, and culture and inclusion with accompanying measures, desired outcomes and progress over time.
- ➔ Enhance school community knowledge and beliefs regarding inclusion, and develop staff capabilities in planning and delivering school-wide differentiated teaching and learning that meets the diverse learning needs of all students.
